

8.1 CLEFT

Meenakshi Cleft and Craniofacial Centre (MCCC) performed nearly 310 cleft and 37 craniofacial operations this year. There was an equal amount of primary and secondary cleft surgeries performed this year. 59 orthodontic treatments also started during this year.

In the year 2018 we had a good number of Screening Camps held both in Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh, through which our centre's name became very familiar among Local people and also with other medical fraternities. In July 2018 along with the collaboration with Deputy Director Health Services, Cheyyar, Tamil Nadu we conducted screening camps in different parts of the district so that all the patients in that district can be covered.

This helped us to popularize our centre and we also got referral from other district medical officers. Dr. Manikandhan & team has discussed with the administrative in charge Mr. Elumalai regarding next year's annual plan for camp programs to increase the patient inflow. We conducted various screening camps and were able to mobilize around 20 patients in that district.

After successful screening and treatment at patient's disposal, we also got good feedback from the district authorities and they also assured that they will conduct camps regularly and send us patients, and conduct possible camps in the month of March / April upcoming year. In Andhra Pradesh also a total number of 3 camps conducted during July to September 2018 through which we were able to cover major districts namely Prakasam, Chittoor and Nellore.

We can proudly say that we are the one of the leading centers for cleft patients from south of Andhra Pradesh. A new Cleft orthodontic wing comprising of 4 teams with each team comprising of one professor and, one reader and 2 senior lecturers has been started in the orthodontics department. Each team per week will take care of cleft patients which will enable us to attend to the cleft patients efficiently and also regulate the materials being used for these patients. A total of 59 cases have been treated by the Orthodontic Department for the year 2018.

8.2 ELLAM THEDI EYAN MURAI MARUTHUVAM (ETEM)

Ellam Thedi Eyan Murai Maruthuvam (ETEM) conducted 30 camps in 30 villages with 60 students under the guidance of 3 staffs covering 30 villages in 10 days with the support of Mrs. Chitra Vijayakumar, a total of 929 people got benefitted through the camps. In continuation, 5 camps were conducted in the villages of Tiruvallur district with the help of Mrs. P Dhatchayani benefitting 303 people with 100 students and 2 faculty members.
