



14. Flagship Projects of MAHER

14.1 CLEFT

This year Meenakshi Cleft and Craniofacial Centre (MCCC) has performed nearly 269 cleft and 37 craniofacial surgeries. There was an equal amount of primary and secondary

cleft surgeries performed this year. 39 new orthodontic treatments were also started during this year.

In the year 2019 we had a reduced number of Screening Camps held in Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh. 90% of our new patients were either walk-ins or due to personal references from our old patients and known medical fraternities.

In March 2019 along with the collaboration with Rotary club of Erode (Tamil Nadu) and Rotary International, we conducted screening camps in different parts of the district which helped cover a large population of that district.

After successful screening and fast patient disposal, we got very positive feedback from the rotary district authorities with assurance that they will conduct camps regularly and refer us patients. The schedule for the next possible camps may be in the month of March / April 2020.

This year we are working more vigorously to achieve target of 400 patients in cleft and 50 in craniofacial numbers. A significant increase of the number of cleft centers in Tamil Nadu from 2 in 2003 to 10 currently has diluted the patient referral network.

We get patients regularly through referral from Andhra Pradesh and we can proudly say that we are the one of the leading centers for cleft patients from south of Andhra Pradesh.

The Cleft orthodontic wing comprises of 4 teams with each team comprising of one professor and, one reader and 2 senior lecturers. Each team rotates on a weekly basis for care of cleft patients which will enable us to attend to the cleft patients efficiently and also regulate the materials being used for these patients. A total of 39 cases have been treated by the Orthodontic Department for the year 2019.

14.2 ELLAM THEDI EYAN MURAI MARUTHUVAM (ELEM)

The Ellam Thedi Eyan Murai Maruthuvam (ELEM) camp have been conducted in 3 seasons covering 31 villages in 19 days with 30 camps by the students along with 6 senior faculties. Overall 1119 patients are benefitted by this camp.

- Session I (7-10-2019 to 12-10-2019): 9 villages have been covered with 255 beneficiaries, One self-help station was provided in the Pallipettu government high school, the science teacher were trained to provide the facility for in & around villagers.

- Session II (10-12-2019 to 15-12-2019): 12 camps in 10 villages at thiruvallur district, 60 students have been facilitated with 2 faculties to reach the interior part of the villagers, 428 people benefitted by this camp.
- Session III (02-03-2020 to 08-03-2020): 60 Students from the final year conducted 15 camps in 7 days, under the guidance of 2 faculties covering 12 villages with 436 beneficiaries.
