In the present year, a total of three new programs were introduced which include M.Sc Medical Microbiology, D.Sc., M.A English., thus making the total number of programs offered as 77. Academic flexibility was introduced by implementation of CBCS as well as electives in various programs where provision exists. In fact, in the present year 100% of the programs have such kind of academic flexibility, a major strength of the curriculum offered at MAHER. This portrays the student centered teaching learning process that is imparted at MAHER. In addition to this, the number of courses in the 77 programs that are inter/intra/transdisciplinary in nature include 604 of the total 1100 courses which account for 55% of the total courses. Being a multidisciplinary institute, there is wider scope for providing interdisciplinary training.



### CURRICULUM DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT





## **RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, AND CONSULTANCY**

MAHER believes that research and development is the only way forward and is dedicated to providing a conducive environment to promote quality research. MAHER has three research laboratories that are equipped with all major equipment to conduct sophisticated research and provide scope for providing consultancy services. In 2021-2022, MAHER granted seed money of INR 1.34 crores to its faculty members to kick-start their research projects.



This encouraged them to attract extramural research funding from various government and

non-government organizations. A steady improvement in the number of funded projects obtained by the institution was noticed when compared to the previous years which shows the enthusiastic nature of the faculty members, scholars and students.




MAHER takes great pride that the Indian Council of Medical Research selected 21 projects


The MAHER faculty members generated a total of 965 indexed publications, propelling the



## **INNOVATIONS AND INCUBATION**

MAHER has a well-established Institution Innovation Council (IIC) certified by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, in 2021. The Ministry of Health, Government of India, for conducting the IPR Impact Lecture Series for 2021-22, selected MAHER's IIC. MAHER's Incubation and Innovation Center is spread over 10,000 sq ft with state-of-the-art infrastructure. The Institution has applied for grant-in-aid under the Atal Innovation Mission, Government of India. The faculty members of MAHER have been actively engaged in the generation of intellectual properties, the cost of which is entirely borne by MAHER as indicated in the Research Promotion Policy. A total of 12 patents, 173 copyrights, and 45 design patents have been granted by the Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Government of India, in addition to 107 patents that are published and are in the process of review.



The institution's Innovation Council proactively conducted many programs with the objective of spreading innovation culture among all stakeholders. All programs that were conducted were uploaded in the dedicated portal of the MIC and following scrutiny, the institution was awarded 2 star rating out of 5 star for the current year.



## INFRASTRUCTURE

MAHER ensures optimal allocation and proper utilization of its financial resources towards maintaining and uplifting its infrastructural facilities. In line with this, MAHER has disbursed an amount of INR 19.24 crores towards infrastructure development in 2021-2022. In the current year, MAHER has upgraded the learning management system by procuring the internationally acclaimed CANVAS Learning Management System for the benefit and ease of students. The e-governance system of MAHER was also updated by procuring Enterprise Resource Planning software to efficiently manage student affairs, the teaching-learning process, finance, and the examination process. The research wing of MAHER has also received a face-lift and has been provided with state of an art cell culture lab with an investment of INR 30.0 lakhs. The Central Library at MAHER and the constituent colleges were integrated with providing remote access to students and staff.

Further, the library has been fully automated through RFID technology, with an investment of around INR 45 lakhs. The e-learning sources available in the library were enhanced by subscribing to various databases worth INR 75.0 lakhs, including DELNET, PROQUEST, J-Gate, EBSCO Host, and Elsevier Clinical Keys for Clinicians. In addition, the library has been upgraded with the latest editions of textbooks amounting to INR 20.0 Lakhs.

The program was well received and students expressed their complete satisfaction for organizing the program.



## FACULTY TRAINING AND WELFARE

Faculty members are encouraged to pursue advanced studies and are supported by the Institution adequately. MAHER provides financial assistance of INR 6.0 lakhs to train 30 faculty members in simulation by the prestigious Hull Institute of Learning and Simulation, United Kingdom, in 2022. The Common Wealth Institute, United Kingdom, trained nearly 430 faculty members of MAHER on E-content development which MAHER supported. All faculty members with a health science background attended the workshop on "Principles of Good Clinical Practice" with MAHER's financial support towards the program's registration fee. Financial support amounting to INR 4.36 lakhs was given to faculty members to attend conferences, workshops, and other academic deliberations in 2021-22. The Human Resource Development Centre of MAHER organized soft skill and technical skill enhancement programs for the non-teaching staff of MAHER. By collaborating with Toronto - Nichi-In Centre for

Regenerative Medicine, MAHER facilitated 10 of its staff members to obtain fellowship from the University of Toronto. All MAHER staff and students are added as group insurance policy beneficiaries. They are insured for a sum of INR 2.0 lakhs, for which the Institution paid the premium. Staff members, scholars, and students who have brought recognition to the Institution through their achievement in the field of research, consultancy, extension activities, academics, and extra-curricular activities have been recognized and honored with commendation awards and cash prizes amounting to INR 1.57 lakhs as a part of College day celebration.

### **Evaluation Process:**

The evaluation of answer sheets is carried out in a fair and transparent manner. The examiners are given the answer key to evaluate as set by the QP setter while evaluating the answer sheets, and they are required to adhere to a strict deadline for completing the evaluation process. The evaluation of answer scripts is done as per the governing council norms. Faculty from other university/ Institutions are appointed as Examiners for evaluating the Answer Booklets and all necessary arrangements were made by the examination section. Evaluation of Answer Booklets

is supervised by COE, Dy.CoE and Asst.CoE with the help of section assistants. Marks awarded by the examiners are entered into the database immediately by the respective data operators and the result processing is automated.

## **STUDENTS' GRADUATION AND PLACEMENT**

MAHER is responsible for producing highly talented graduates and finding suitable placements for them upon graduation. MAHER maintains a high graduation percentage that ranges between 80-100%. Nearly 80% of students either progress to higher education or get placed comfortably. Most of the programs offered at MAHER are professional, enabling the graduates to start their own practice and explore their entrepreneurial skills. MAHER also provides training for various competitive exams that help students crack these exams and pursue their higher education. The Placement Cell of MAHER played a pivotal role in conducting 18 placement drives for 2021-2022, through which 632 students benefitted.

### **Internal Quality Assurance Cell:**

The internal quality assurance cell of MAHER convened four times in the current year as per the recommendations of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council. The Cell took many quality initiatives targeting many spheres of functioning including Laboratories, examination system, hospital administration, curricular aspect, teaching and learning process as well as research. 

## **INSTITUTIONAL SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY**

MAHER has four NSS units with 400 volunteers participating in socially responsible activities, including Swachh Bharath, Clean India Campaign, Lake and Beach Cleaning, tree plantation, etc. In addition, under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan scheme, MAHER conducted various programs, including COVID-19 awareness Programs, breastfeeding, Diabetes, Pulse Polio, Women empowerment, Health, and Lifestyle in the adopted villages. MAHER has conducted many social extension activities involving 100 % of students with a total expenditure of INR 17.04 lakhs for 2021-2022. In the present year a total of 206 camps were conducted which was a substantial increase when compared to the previous years. This was possible because of the lift in the lockdown by the government following the improvement in COVID 19 condition. Further the Faculty of Physiotherapy conducted the ambitious project of

“Physiotherapy on Wheels” for the fifth consecutive year in which 151 camps were conducted in span of 35 days in which 55 villages were covered. The program received widespread appreciation from the village administrative Heads.



MAHER partnered with the Environment Federation of India, an NGO, to conduct a Chennai seashore cleaning activity over five weeks in which more than 553 students participated. Similarly, students cleaned heritage temples and government parks in and around the Kanchipuram district. The Institution sponsored the construction of toilets in government schools to contribute towards Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. With the interest of creating political and democracy awareness, Youth Parliament Club for students was created in 2022, in which 55 students participated in the Mock Parliament activity. The students and scholars of the Faculty of Yoga science and therapy have taken up the noble cause of empowering rural India by conducting skill training and health promotion activities. The Faculty of Physiotherapy started the ambitious project of providing physiotherapy and pain relief at the doorsteps of 66 villages and hamlets in Tamil Nadu. This initiative received wide recognition and was deeply appreciated by the Government of Tamil Nadu.





Today, on the 16<sup>th</sup> Convocation Day of MAHER, a total number of 1053 candidates, including undergraduates and postgraduates, will be awarded degrees and diplomas. 75 of them shall receive medals and certificates for their commendable performance, 25 will receive Ph.D. degrees, and one will receive D.Sc. Degree in person. We extend our hearty congratulations to all the awardees, graduates, and postgraduates. We are very proud to honor Dr. Bashi V. Velayudhan with Honoris causa for his outstanding contribution to the cardiothoracic and vascular surgery field for more than 40 years. In addition to graduates, we are happy to award Gomathi Radhakrishnan Distinguished Alumni Award to our alumni who excel in various fields. Finally, it is a proud moment to honor the 'Paalam' Kalyanasundaram, who donated every rupee he earned to the poor for 30 years with Jayanthi Radhakrishnan Award for
